TRYOUT LOCATION & RULES

Tryouts will be held inside the Northwood Gym Stage 12:00pm-3:00pm

- Tryouts and practices are closed to family, friends, and the public.
- Participants are <u>required</u> to <u>attend all tryout dates.</u> You are responsible for knowing all of the required material for tryouts.
 - All participants are expected to be **ON TIME** and dressed appropriately for tryouts.
 - Hair must be pulled back off your face in a tight ponytail or bun.
 - Absolutely NO JEWELRY or GUM chewing!!!
- There are NO GUARANTEED SPOTS and there is the possibility that not everyone trying out will make the team.

NOTE: According to MCPS regulations, the coach has final approval of the selection of the squad. The confidential scores of the judges are considered a recommendation only.

ACADEMICS/ELIGIBILITY

Academics come first! Pom members are expected and encouraged to use proper time management skills to manage their homework and social life. Montgomery County requires all athletes to maintain a 2.0 GPA average at all times, with no more than one E. (Academics are not negotiable; if you fail to maintain the county issued 2.0 GPA you will be dismissed from the squad, in accordance with county policies.

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Poms team is a one of the dynamic spirit teams here at Northwood High School. They represent Northwood's competitive dance team and perform at all varsity home games for Football & Basketball. The team also travels to 3-4 competitions within Montgomery County. The poms program is a varsity-only sport and runs for multiple seasons.

SEASONS

Fall - During the fall season the team is required to attend 5 varsity football games at home.

Winter- During the winter season the team is required to attend at least 14 home basketball games for both boys & girls varsity and compete in a minimum of 2 competitions.

[Athletes earn their varsity letter after the completion of both fall & winter season for poms]

PRACTICE SCHEDULE

The team will practice 3-4 days a week during both the fall and winter season inside the Northwood Dance Studio. All practices are mandatory and a note from a parent/guardian will be required if an athlete misses practice. 3 unexcused absences will cause team member to be removed from upcoming game/competition.

Parents and students are asked to familiarize themselves with our team calendar on (northwoodsports.org) to avoid any unnecessary conflicts. [Please keep in mind as we move into winter season that some Saturday practices may be scheduled so the team can access the gym] It is imperative that we have all dancers present during practices. If a student is able to sit in on rehearsals that is encouraged over missing practices.

DRESS CODE

Most spirit teams have a dress code and we are no different. Dancers are asked to wear the required uniform to each and every practice complete with jazz shoes. In order to clean routines and look organized we strictly enforce our team dress code.
